



Extracurricular Activities

At Jeanne D'Arc British International School students are offered a variety of Extra Curricular Activities (ECA) and After School Activities (ASA) which allow students to explore their interests or try new activities outside of the school curriculum. Extra Curricular Activities are offered by internal teachers and run in school during the week after school or on Friday afternoons.

Extra Curricular Activities and After School Activities are not just about sports. There is an Extra Curricular Activity or After School Activity for most students' interests at JDA. A high level of interaction with friends is encouraged through a range of activities from craft and computing and drama.

JDA offers Extra Curricular Activities and After School Activities ranging from sports to robotics. In addition to other programmes, our students are taken on school visits away from school three times a year for a fun day. These events provide opportunities for all classes in the school to bond and build strong relationships.
